Decision: 2010- 887

This is in reference to the **Wing Tip** putter, received on October 7, 2010, which you submitted for an official ruling. This is a standard-length, mallet-style putter featuring a wooden, weighted head.

Please be advised that the putter, as submitted, has been evaluated and it has been determined that it conforms to the Rules of Golf. However, please submit any modifications to the existing design (including hosel design, significant shaft length variations, shaft angle, etc.) for an official ruling.

This ruling applies only to the sample submitted and any clubs manufactured identical to it. This ruling does not apply if there is any change in the design, manufacture, material or construction of this particular club. If a club of similar design, with identical markings is acquired from any source and found to fail USGA standards, then the conformance status of the club will be reviewed.

In advertisements of the **Wing Tip** putter, you are authorized to make the statement: "**Conforms with USGA Rules.**" Use of the USGA seal or logo, and/or statements such as "USGA Approved" or "USGA Tested" is prohibited. Please note that you are prohibited from displaying USGA trademarked and copyrighted material on your product, including the USGA logo and/or U.S. Open logos. Displaying such material may result in revocation of this decision.

We are retaining the sample as a record of this decision.

The USGA reserves the right to change the Rules and interpretations regulating equipment at any time.
